FOYER GALLERY - 2012

The Art Institute & Gallery (AI&G) is now accepting applications for one-person juried exhibits in the Foyer Gallery for the 2012 schedule. Foyer Gallery exhibits open concurrently with the regularly scheduled AI&G shows and will hang for approximately four weeks.

Application fee: \$35(non-refundable). Applicants must be members of the AI&G. Non-members may include a **PAID 2012 MEMBERSHIP** application with their entry forms.

ENTRY AND SELECTION PROCESS

Submit an entry form accompanied by *five* 4 x 6 in. (or 5 x 7 in.) photographs or digital prints. Include your name and artwork title on the back of each photo. Prepare a 3 x 5 in. card for each photo; include the following on each card: last name, title of work, medium, size, and date of completion. Submit a brief biography and short artist statement.

Application deadline: Deadline for 2012 is **Mon. November 3, 2011 @ 2:00 PM**

The jury committee will make decisions by November 10, 2011 and artists will be notified by mail along with information on the dates for hanging your exhibition.

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

- . 2-D original art only
- . No copies or reproductions
- . Open theme and 2D media

COMMISSION

The AI&G will retain a 30% commission on works sold.

HANGING AND CLOSING THE EXHIBITS

The Foyer Gallery, a narrow hallway entrance area, offers 30 - 40 linear feet of hanging space.

Artists are not restricted to hanging artwork from submitted images. New work and other work may be hung, provided it fits the parameters listed above under Artwork Specifications.

At least 80% of exhibited artwork must be for sale.

Foyer Gallery artists are responsible for hanging and dismantling their exhibits.

Work must be hung in a single row; work must not be double stacked. At least 12 inches should be allowed between small works, more between larger works.

Artists are responsible for filling nail holes in the walls upon exhibit closing and touching up nail holes with paint. Materials will be provided.

LIABILITY

The AI&G will take every precaution against damage and theft of artwork, but will not be responsible for damage or loss whatever the cause.
