## **Eligibility**

The exhibition is open all artists and fine crafters in all media. In time for holiday giving, all art works must be available for sale. Artists are encouraged to offer works at affordable prices to encourage holiday giving. The goal of this exhibition is to sell your artworks.

## **Judge: Ken Basile, Salisbury, MD**

Ken Basile has worked in the arts and museums for over 50 years. He has worked with the Smithsonian Institution's Museum of American History, the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum, the Ward Museum of Wildfowl Art, Salisbury University, The Genesee Country Museum, the Salisbury University Galleries and the Calumet Institute. He has served on a number of boards of arts and letters institutions. Ken holds a BA in History from the University of Maryland, College Park and an MA in Art/ Museum Studies from the University of Delaware. He has lived with his wife Karen and three children on the Eastern Shore of Maryland since 1972.

## **Show Acceptance and Installation:**

**The Holiday Artist Show and Sale will encourage the purchase of artist's works. Only original work is accepted for competition. Original works completed at any point of the artists' career may be submitted with no limitation on age of art. All entries must be available for sale.**

All 2D work **must be ready for hanging** with suitable wire or other wall mounting. No double saw tooth hangers. Entries requiring unusual installation require prior approval with AI&G. To ensure proper installation of non-traditional works, AI&G may require the assistance of the artist. AI&G retains the final decision regarding works to be exhibited.

## **Specifications and Reserves**

Work must not exceed 100 lbs. 2D work must not exceed 48 x 48 inches including frame. 3D work must not exceed 30" in two of its dimensions and 5' in the third dimension. The

AI&G reserves the right to photograph and reproduce images for publicity purposes. All unsold accepted work must remain in the exhibition for its duration.

## **Identification and Labeling of Entries**

Place the following information on **both** cards: artist's name, title of artwork, size, medium, and price. Loosely tape one card onto the front of each artwork. Provide typed list of bin art with same information & price.
